Mayor opens state of the art multi purpose centre eSikhaleni

“City of uMhlathuze Mayor

Community members of mainly section H2 at eSikhaleni and surroundings are breathing a sigh of relief as the state of the art municipal centre is officially open for community usage.

City of uMhlathuze Mayor Cllr Mduduzi Mhlongo, said this is a swift response by the caring municipality following the request by the community to bring municipal facilities closer to them in the same standard as those in town and suburbs.

“About a year or so we had communities of section H2 as well as the residents of the then hostels protesting about few things that the municipality should attend to. Amongst those, was the issue of this facility which was dilapidating. I personally came here to receive the grievances that we will attend

to. The handover of the facility to the community will offer more convenience such as five cashier counters to ease long queues and decrease time of offering our services. We are working with the KZN Department of Transport to finalise a few compliance matters for the traffic kiosk where motorists will now renew vehicle licences nearby where they live instead of travelling to eMpangeni or Richards Bay,” Mhlongo said.

Mhlongo also took part in the Siyasizana Consumer Education campaign wherein he engaged community members on the issue of water and electricity supply and other services rendered by the City of uMhlathuze. “We would like to apologise upfront on how we supply you with mainly water. We are experiencing a number of challenges in our infrastructure and we are working



on that with our engineers. What we ought to do is to always inform you in advance when we will have a planned shut down and when water will be restored, except in exceptional cases such as the pipe bursts,” Mhlongo said.

The community/customers will now have an opportunity to receive the same quality service offered in Richards Bay main office with additional three private offices or cubicles for private payment arrangements for those who are financially constrained.

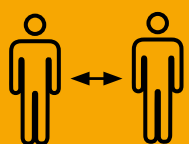
The upgrade also include a bigger Accounts Enquiries Section to accommodate the high number of customers who are served in eSikhawini and surroundings for their municipal account enquiries.

The office physical features are now accommodative of people with a disability with a widened doorway to allow a wheelchair to pass through easily. The eSikhawini H2 offices also accomodates Human Settlement and Corporate Services and Hall Bookings.

Amathangi amanzi anikezelwe umphakathi ukuqinisekisa ukuthi unamanzi amaningi ukuze ukwazi ukuzhlala uhlanzekile futhi unempilo ngesikhathi sokulwa negciwane i-coronavirus.

UMPHAKATHI waseMhlathuze ikakhulukazi owentula amanzi ageleza ngamapayipi uthole ukwengezelwa ngamathangi angaphezulu kuka-100 ukuqinisekisa ukuthi unamanzi amaningi ukuze ukwazi ukuzhlala uhlanzekile futhi unempilo ngesikhathi sokulwa negciwane i-coronavirus.

Lama thangi amakhulu afakwe ezindaweni zomphakathi ezisemakhaya Kanye nasemawadini anezinkinga zamanzi. Amanye amathangi afakwe emarenke ukuze abagibeli, abadayisi, abashayeli nabanikazi bezinto zokuthutha bakwazi ukuthola amanzi okuhlamba izandla kanye nawokuphuza. Lama

thange awokwengeza njengoba amarenke amaningi akhiwa wuMasipala uMhlathuze enazo izindlu zangasese ezinamanzi ompompi Kanye nawokuphuza. Ukwengeza kwenzelwe ukukhuthaza wonke umuntu nongenaso isidingo sokungena endlini encane, ukuba akwazi ukuwasha izandla uma ehla noma engena ekhumbini kumbe ebhasini.

Lama thangi azohlale njalo egcwaliswa amanzi ngamaloli athutha amanzi ajwayelekile. Ukwengeza amathangi kuza nokulethwa kwezimoto ezimbili zamanzi ukuze zilekelele njengoba amathangi esemaningi ngalesi sikhathi isizwe sonke sisalwa nobhubhane lwe-Coronavirus.

UMnyango wezokuBambisana neziNdaba zoMdabu ezweni kanye naKwaZulu-Natal, yiwona ohamba phambili kulolu hlelo nokuqinisekisa ukuthi umyalelo okhishwe wuhulumeni wokuthi bonke abantu kumele babe namanzi uyagcineka.

City of uMhlathuze Food Bank launched to assist COVID-19 victims and beyond



To date, the Food Bank has distributed to more than 20 000 people in all 34 wards. This is 100 per ward and to vulnerable groups establishments such as elderly homes, etc. Each food parcel can feed a family of more than 5 members. Companies and conglomerates such as Tronox, Mondi, South 32, Red Cross, Richards Bay Minerals and many other have contributed thus far.

His Excellency Cyril Ramaphosa declared a national state of disaster due to the novel Coronavirus which erupted in 2019.

Pursuant to this declaration a national lockdown was affected initially from 26 March 2020 and later extended to 30 April 2020. As a consequence, of which South Africans of all walks of life find themselves facing harsh reality of life under strict restrictions.

It is important to remind the communities that the lockdown was declared by the President in an effort to put under control the spread of the Coronavirus that threatens the very existence of human life globally.

Consequently, the regulations under which the lockdown was declared has brought about enormous challenges to an already struggling economy, and this has resulted in an even more severe impact to those who already live below the poverty line.

Working together with the

Department of Social Development, The South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) and King Cetshwayo District Municipality, the uMhlathuze Food Bank will target the most affected and the poorest of the poor: The Indigent • Child Headed Households • The elderly • The Unemployed • Grant Receiving • Women & Children and those who are unable to go out and get essential needs for themselves.

Our sole preoccupation through the establishment of this Food Bank is to ensure that the citizens of uMhlathuze are given a fighting chance to survive this lockdown and are able to abide by the regulations imposed upon them. We would like to take this opportunity to reassure the people of uMhlathuze that this process will be as transparent as possible, free of corruption, nepotism, maladministration and will target the most deserving.

This will be done through a rigorous screening process that is in line with methods prescribed by COGTA, SASSA and DSD through their food distribution processes.

We will be keeping a strict register of goods received and a list of beneficiaries signed by them as confirmation of receipt.

In line with the regulations, all activities undertaken by council during lockdown will be reported to council once lifted.

The City of uMhlathuze calls upon the private sector and private individuals to donate to the Food Bank so that this initiative achieves an unprecedented

reach across the City and touches the lives of those who do not even think they would be reached.

Therefore, as a sign of our good faith and commitment to this noble initiative, we have taken the decision to procure as a baseline 2000 food packs, which will be distributed to all wards.

The method of distribution, will be communicated to those who qualify as beneficiaries to avoid security hazards as experienced elsewhere in the country.

Going forward, we wish to request small scale farmers within our jurisdiction to register themselves on our platforms.

As part of kick-starting the local economy, the municipality is looking to procure certain fresh produce from them which will be included in the pack.

Lastly, we urge our communities to work with us by being responsible citizens and think for those who are truly struggling and put them first.

It is through selflessness that we can build a truly united and prosperous society and if we unite through this time of need, we stand a chance to be a shining example for the entire country to see and emulate.

This launch today is the start of something great and meaningful. We need to roll up our sleeves and pull together to work for the people of the City of uMhlathuze through their hour of need.

We hope this Food Bank can be as impactful as we anticipate it to be. As Amilcar Cabral emphasised, **“Always bear in mind that the people are not fighting for ideas, for the things in anyone’s head. They are fighting to win material benefits, to live better and in peace, to see their lives go forward, to guarantee the future of their children.”**

In conclusion, it would be remiss of me if I do not on behalf of the people of uMhlathuze and Council thank the astute leadership which has been displayed by the South African Government and working together, we can successfully fight the COVID-19 pandemic.

As President Cyril Ramaphosa stated that; “This epidemic will pass. But it is up to us to determine how long it will last.”

Let us practice social distancing, stay at home, rinse our hands regularly and sanitise.

Multi-million rand projects handed over to Ntambanana Community



The City of uMhlathuze officially handed over community projects worth more than R10 million at Bhucanana in Ward 33, Ntambanana.

Ntambanana community members, izinduna, representative from iNkosi Biyela Tribal Authority, braved heavy rain to witness and receive projects that were developed to better their lives by the City of uMhlathuze.

Speaker Councillor Slondile Mkhize handed over the Material Recovery Facility, which is also a Waste Transfer Station in Bhucanana. This facility is a centre for all solid waste collected from households in the ward and deposited in one area so that it can be transferred to eMpangeni Landfill site in bulk. It also serves as a place where members of the community and or organisations can sort reusable waste such as cans, bottles, plastic material and papers for recycling purposes.

Mkhize also went on to officially open the Community Park, which the community can use for weddings, recreational purposes, etc. The park consists of an amphitheatre set-up, playing facilities for children, braai stands, lounging concrete seats and it

is fenced for security reasons. Mkhize also met with more than 400 community members in Mancence Community Hall to hand over this state-of-the-art facility. The hall was a response to the outcry of the Mancence community in the erstwhile Ntambanana Municipality. The hall can be utilised for community services such as weddings, funerals, meetings and other activities that may even economically benefit members of the community.

“We are handing over these projects to you and we are expecting you as members of the community to take care of them because they belong to you. We are also encouraging young and women to seize the economic benefit brought about by the Material Recovery Facility to turn waste into money. For now, only two women are recovering some material and selling it to buy back centres and are now surviving through that money. The community park as well as the hall also requires that we add some innovations in the near future such as WIFI connectivity so that whilst people enjoy the park, they also use it for their own benefit, more especially young people,” said Mkhize.

“Inkinga enkulu idaleke ngesikhathi sokuholwa kwezimpesheni kwazise kuvulwe leso sikhathi sekunqunywe ukuthi izwe liyavalwa. Abantu bathutheleke ngobuningi ezindaweni zokuholela impesheni nokwenze imiyalezo yokuqhelelana nokushiyelana izikhala kolayini yagcina ifuna ukufekela. Yilaphoke

sithunywe khona ukuba siyolekelela ukufundisa abantu bakithi ngalesi sifo,”kusho uMkhize.

Likhulu ithemba lokuthi leli siko elisha lizojwayeleka. “Abantu bakithi kumele bazijwayeze ukwenza izinto ezintsha manje njengokuqhelelana kolayini. Nasezitolo sekumiwa ulayini

ngaphandle ukulawula isibalo sabantu abangaphakathi esitolo. Lokhu kwenza abantu baphakanyelwe yimimoya kodwa kancane kancane bazofunda ukuhlela izinto ngenye indlela futhi kusenesikhathi ngoba kubukeka kuyiyona mpilo entsha esesizoyiphila lena,”kuchaza uSibiya.

SIZAMA NGOKUSEMANDLENI UKUFUQA INTUTHUKO NGAPHANSI KWEZIMO EZINZIMA ZOBHUBHANE LWE-CORONA

Kusezimweni ezinzima njengalezi ke lapho kumele ke sijule ngemicabango sibukisise kahle izimo esibhekene nazo njengesizwe ukuze sicabe kahle indlela emazombezombe esisazoyihamba.

Impokophelo yethu yezombusazwe nezinqumo esizithathayo kumele ziqikelele ukuthi zenza izwe kanye nendawo yethu iphinde iphephe ngokuthi sikwazi ukunqoba ubhubhane loKhuvethe oluhlalise kanzima wonke umuntu.

Sidinga ukunakekelana ngalesi sikhathi, sidinga ukubumbana njengezwe ukunqoba lesi sifo ngokuthi senze lokho esiyalelwa ukuba sikwenze.

Njengezakhamizi zaseMhlathuze, sidinga ukubamba elethu iqhaza ngokuqiniseka ukuthi silandela yonke imigomo esiyibekelwa wuhulumeni kazwelonke nokuqiniseka ukuthi sihlonipha yonke imithetho ngokuthi sihlale emakhaya ukunqanda ukutheleleka nokubhebhethaka koKhuvethe.

Ingqalabutho yombhali ozalwa eGermany u-Eckhart Tolle encwadini yakhe esihloko sithi, A New Earth-Awakening to your life's purpose, uthi: "Uma ubhekene nomqansa nezivuvaba, indlela endala yokuphila emhlabeni, indlela yokuxhumana nabanye abantu, nenqubo yemvelo isishabalele, uma ukuphila kwabantu sekubhekene nezingqinamba ezinganqandeki, lapho umuntu kumbe izilwane sekubhekene nokufa kumbe ukushintsha ukwenza ukhohlwe yikho konke okujwayelekile kepha uhambisane nokusha okusuke sekufikile kukuphoqa ukuba uhambisane nakho."

Umengameli wezwe uMhlonishwa u-Cyril Ramaphosa, ukhulume nesizwe ngomhlaka-15 March 2020, eshaya umgomo kathaqa ezweni ngokulawulwa wuMthetho weZimo eziBucayi, uyalele isizwe ukuba sivule amehlo ngobhubhane olukhungezwe izwe i-COVID-19.

Sizemukele izimemezelo zikaMengameli zokushaya umgomo kathaqa ezweni njengengxenywe ebalulekile yokunqanda ukubhebhethaka kwegciwane uKhuvethe ezweni. Siyazi kuyezwela kakhulu kodwa yinqubo lena ehlolwe ngochwepheshe bethu kanye nabomhlaba wonke yabhabhadiswa nayinhlangano yomhlaba yezempilo i-World Health Organisation (WHO).

Lisanda kufika leli gciwane kwakungukuthi kubhekwa kakhulu abantu abake bahambela kwamanye amazwe kakhulu kodwa ngokushesha izinto zishintshile njengoba selisabalala nakulabo abangakaze baye

kwamanye amazwe muva nje, kodwa selisabalala kuwona wonke umuntu oke wasondelana nonalo.

Isizwe ke sesikwazile ukubekezela kunzima saze sehliselwa esigabeni sesi-4 samazinga alesi sifo ezweni lonke, lapho kuxegiswe khona kancane imigomo kwavulelwa nengxenywe encane yabasebenzi namabhizinisi ukuba avule.

Siyaxuswa ukuba sithobele imigomo yawo wonke amazinga ukuze lingabhebhetheki leli gciwane. Ukuthobela kwethu imithetho kuzokwenza ukuthi isizwe sisheshe singene emazingeni aphantsi okuxegiswa kwemigomo kathaqa ngokushesha kuvulwe nezindawo zokusebenza kanye namabhizinisi. Ukungathobeli kwethu le migomo kungasibuyisela ezingeni -5 okungu thaqa wayo yonke into.

Ithimba lethu labaphathi bakamasipala limatasa nokubheka zonke izinto ezingaba yingcuphe engabeka abasebenzi namalungu omphakathi uma kuvulwa amahhovisi ngokokulawula kwemigomo yesigaba-4. Lokhu kuhlenganisa ukukhuculula nokuhlaza amahhovisi kamasipala afuthwe ngezibulali magciwane, amadepho asezingaweni ezehlukene, nokunye okuningi.

Uma sesihlole kahle ukuthi konke okudinga ukuthi sikwenze sekwenzeke kahle, seneliseka wukuthi siyahambisana nayo yonke imigomo yesigaba ngasinye, siyobe sesiqala ukuvula amahhovisi akwamasipala ngokwehlukana kokubaluleka kwawo.

Yize sisebenza kanzima kulezi zimo, umasipala wethu uzama ngakho konke okusemandleni ukuphakela umphakathi izidingo ngendlela egculisayo zikhathi zonke. Siyaqhubeka nokugxilisa ithemba kubantu bakithi nokubakhuthaza ukuba babambisane

nathi kulomshikashika esibhekene nawo.

Silokhu siqhubekile nokunikeza abantu amanzi, ugesi, ukuqoqwa kukadoti nokunye okuningi lapho esikwazi ukufinyelela khona nsuku zonke. Siyabonga nakulawo malungu omphakathi namakhasimende ethu asishayela ucingo abike lapho ebona khona konakele bese sithumela abasebenzi bethu ukuba bayolungisa ngokushesha.

Kumele sizilungiselele inqubo entsha yokwenza izinto, indlela ezoshintsha izinto nezindlela esisebenza ngazo kwamasipala ukuphakela umphakathi izidingo nendlela esixhumana ngayo nomphakathi. Imigomo isiphoca wonke umuntu ukuba afake isimfonyo esimboza amakhala nomlomo zikhathi zonke uma ephakathi kwabantu, lokhu sekuphoqa nawo wonke umuntu ozovakashela amahhovisi kamasipala.

Wonke umuntu ozovakashela emahhovisi omkhandlu uzophinde ahlanzwe izandla nge-Sanithayiza bese kuphinde kubekwa nemigoqo nezimpawu ehlukana ibanga phakathi kwabantu, kulezi zindawo zethu eziba nolayini babantu abazodinga usizo emahhovisi ethu.

Sikhuthaza umphakathi namakhasimende ethu ukuba ajwayele manje izindlela ezintsha zobuchwepheshe zokukhokhela izinsiza zikamasipala nokuthenga ugesi wekhadi. Sibala lapho phakathi kokunye, ukuthola incwadi ehlonza ukuthi uyisakhamuzi sakuyiphi iwadi, ezijwayele ukutholakala emaKhanseleni, nokunye okuningi. Okuningi ungakwazi ukukuthola ngokushayela inombolo yazikhathi zonke zikamasipala ubuze usizakale ngokushesha ngale kuthi uze uzizele mathupha emahhovisi.

Sethula lesi sabelo-mali ngaphansi kwesimo somnotho okwembulwa kwembeswa kusona futhi akukacaci ukuthi singase siphaphame nini. Yize kanjalo, sikwazile ukubeka abantu phambili sakwazi ukucabangela amaphakethe abo sikuqonda ukuthi nabo babhekene nesimo esinzima esikhungezwe umhlaba wonke. Ngakolunye uhlangothi, sibhekene nendlela okumele icatshangiswe kahle yokuthi siyitholaphi imali yokuphakela abantu izidingongqangi.

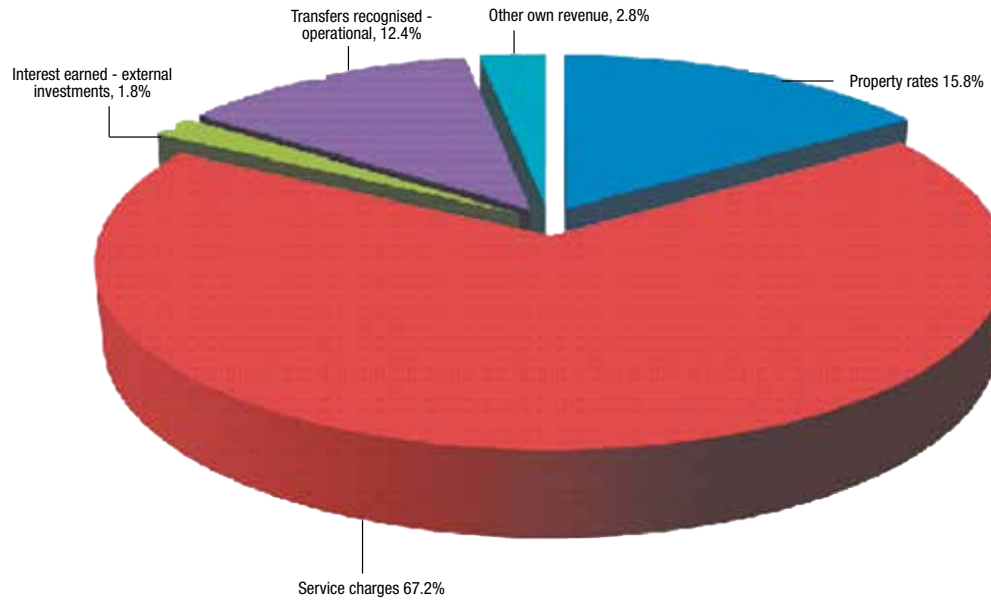

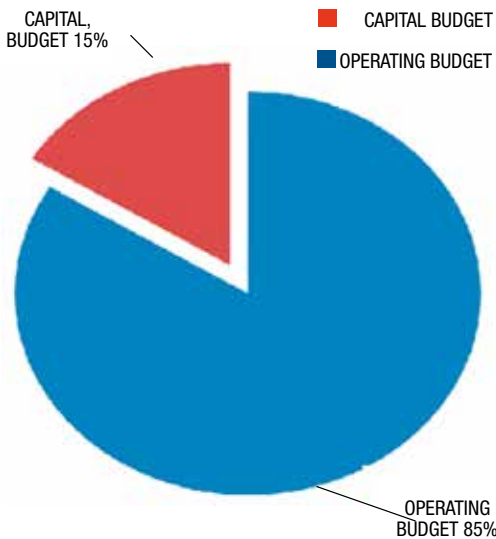

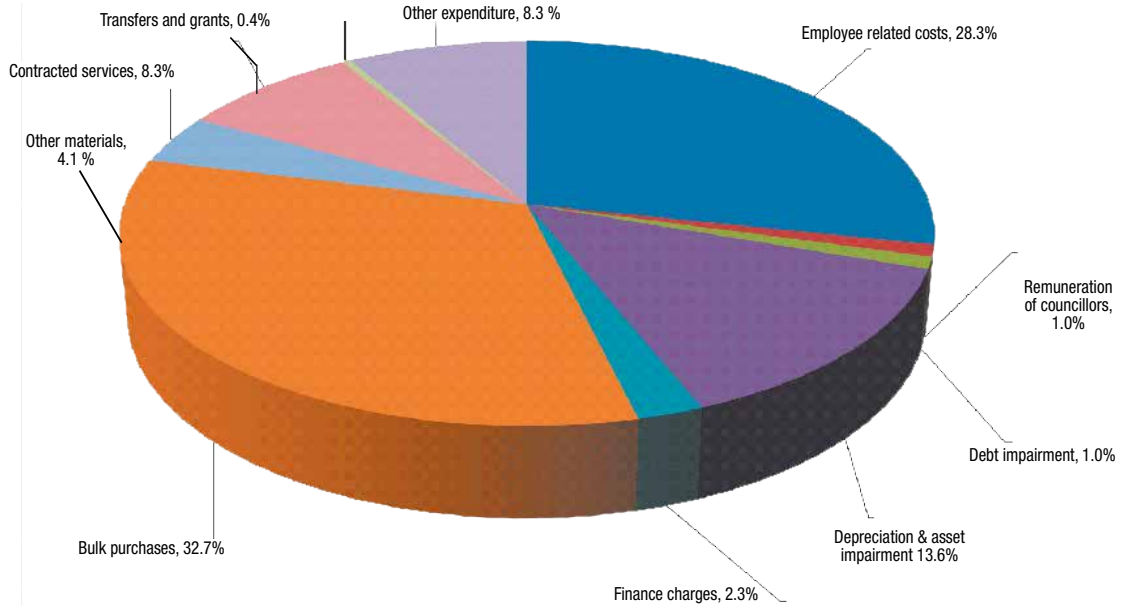
OPERATING REVENUE BUDGET 2020/21 BY SOURCE

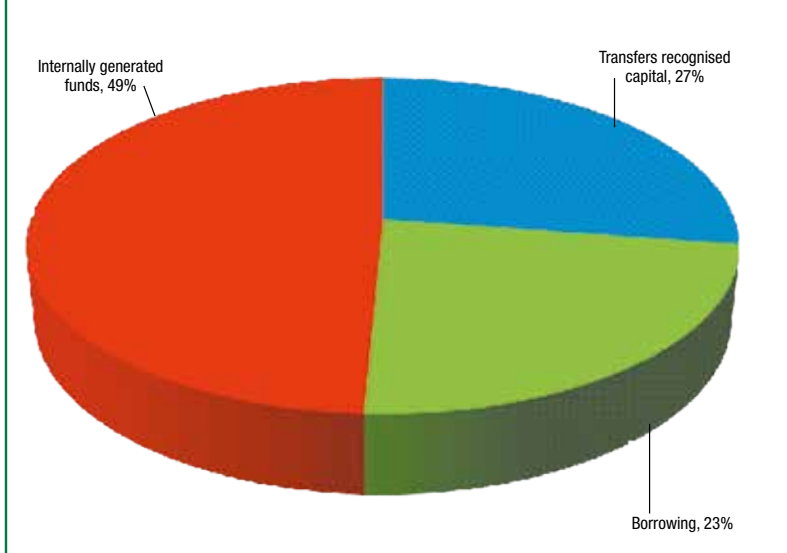

Izinqumo esizithatha manje yizona eziyoba wumhlahlandlela walezo zizukulwane uma zibhekana nenkinga efuze lena kanti nomlando uyosibeka njengabantu nabaholi ababa ngamaqhawe ngokunqoba umbulalazwe wegciwane i-Coronavirus ngokubambisana njengesizwe.

Ukufika kwalesi sifo kufundisa isizwe sonke saseNingizimu Afrika amasiko amasha, kuvuselela imikhuba yenhlanzeko okumele ngabe siyilandela nsuku zonke, kuphinde kusembule amehlo ngokusebenza kobuchwepheshe besimanje bokwenza izinto nokuxhumana nabanye abantu noma bekuphi emhlabeni. Besisayibukela kude i-Fourth Industrial Revolution kodwa ukuvalwa thaqa kwezwe kusenza sibone ukubaluleka kobuchwepheshe nokubufunda kabuhlungu ingasekho enye indlela esingenza ngayo. Lokhu kuzodinga ukuthi iphinde ibhekwe kabusha indaba yamanani e-Data kuphinde kube nezinto ezibalulekile ezingeke zadinga i-Data uma uzidinga ukuze abantu bangacindezeleki ephaketheni. Asithi sizabalaza kanzima silwa nokubhebhethaka kwalesi sifo sibe sikubeka emqondweni ukuthi impilo izoba njani emuva kwaso ngoba nginesiqiniseko sokuthi impilo ngeke iphinde ifane nangaphambi kokuba sifike.

Kubantu abansundu, umkhuba wokuxhawulana nokwangana ushabalala ngokushesha nokuzomele isizwe sikuqonde ukuthi akuve kuchaza ukungathandani kodwa wukuvikela ukusondelana kwabantu.

Kunezimboni ezizolahlekelwa unomphelo nokumele zishintshe ukwenza ukuze zikwazi ukuqhubeka nokusebenza zenze inzuzo. Imboni efana neyezokungcebeleka nezindawo zokudla, neyokuhlelwa kwemicimbi kumele zicabangisise ukuthi zizoqhubeka kanjani. Imboni yezemidlalo ingase ibhekisise kabanzi nayo ngoba ihlanganisa izinkumbi zabantu ngesikhathi esisodwa endaweni eyodwa.

Lezi zimboni zinoxhaxha lwezinye izinto ezithembele kuzona ukuze

zisebenze kahle (value chain) njengamaciko, ukudla, iziphuzo, ezokuthutha, njalonjalo. Amabandla nawo azobhekana nokushintsha ukwenza. Ukwenza imisebenzi yeSintu nemigidi eyenziwa emakhaya isengcupheni yokwehliselwa isibalo ngisho nangemuva kwe-Lockdown. Imihlangano eminingi nokufunda sekuzokwenziwa ngobuchwepheshe bokuxhumana emuva kwalo mkhuhlane. Nohulumeni nezinhlaka zakhe kuzomele abuyekeze indlela yokusebenza kugunyazwe eyokuthi abanye abantu basebenzele emakhaya unomphelo. Imboni yezokuthutha ingenye yezingase zilahlekelwe kakhulu kunezinye ikakhukazi amabhathi namatekisi nakulabo abathutha abavakashi bethu.

Okusemqoka kodwa okwamanje wukuthi silibamba kanjani iqhaza ukunqanda ukubhebhethaka kwegciwane, siwubuyisela kanjani umnotho esimweni sawo, kwazise ubuvele usegunjini labagula kakhulu, senza kanjani njengohulumeni ukugwema ukulahleka kwemisebenzi nokuthi siwagxilisa kanjani lama siko amasha okuziphatha kwabantu ngoba umnyombo wokunqoba lesi sifo ulele ekutheni umphakathi ushintshe ukwenza manje nakusasa.

Indawo yethu eMhlathuze ibhekene nengwadla futhi ishayeke ngokuphindwe kaningana njengoba amadolobha ayo afana noRichards Bay anezimboni ezinkulu ezinabasebenzi ababalwa ngezinkulungwane.

Ngale kokuma kwazo ukungasebenzi nokulahlekisa indawo, isifundazwe nezwe lonke ngomnotho, abasebenzi bakulezi zimboni bashaywe ngemfe iphindiwe. Ingingi labantu abasebenza kulezi zimboni bahlala emalokishini akhele uMhlathuze, nokuchaza ukuthi alikho ikhona elingathintekile yilesi sifo. Phezu kwalokho siyisizinda sokuhwebelana namanye amazwe ikakhulukazi kwezokuthutha njengoba sineChweba laseRichards Bay.

Besisajabulela ukuphumelela ukuheha izimboni zamazwe ngamazwe ukuba zizovula amathuba emisebenzi amasha endaweni yethu sizinxenxa ngokubambisana neRichards Bay IDZ noMnyango wezokuThuthukiswa Komnotho, ezokuVakasha noKongiwa kweMvelo KwaZulu-Natal, iHhovisi likaNdanankulu, kodwa sesibhekene nengcuphe yokuphunyukwa yilama thuba esiwasebenzele kanzima kangaka.

Ukubuyekezwa kwendlela yokusebenza okuzokwenziwa wuhulumeni ukubuyisa umnotho ulele ekuziphatheni komphakathi nokuthobela imithetho yezwe nemigomo eshaywe wuhulumeni okuyiyona ezonqanda futhi ilwe nokubhebhethaka kwegciwane nanoma izwe selivuliwe.

Kulobu bunzima esibhekene nabo njengezwe, kumele sibutuse ubuholi bukaMengameli wezwe



nobukaNgqongqoshe wezeMpilo ngokuhlala indlela ebukena ibheke ekunqobeli lolu bhuhane.

Izethulo ezenziwe wuSolwazi Salim Abdool Karim emhlanganweni abe nawo noDkt Zweli Mkhize nezinye izingcithabuchopho kwezokwelapha, zisivule amehlo zasusa inkungu kwabaningi kwaphenduleka nemibuzo ebilokhu ingenampendulo nebiyenza osomathuba bafune ukugxeka izinyathelo ezithathwe wumengameli nohulumeni wonke wakuleli. Sesiyazi ukuthi lesi sigaba sokuhlasela kwalesi sifo kusengesokuqala, lukhulu luyenza luyanyelela uma abantu bengayithobeli imigomo ye-Lockdown. Sesiyazi futhi ukuthi uma singayilandeli imigomo yokuhlaliswa emakhaya nokuba luvanzi emgwaqeni singazithola sivaleleke isikhathi eside uma kuqhutshwa uthaqa wezwe.

Kubalulekile ke ukuyithobela injengoba injalo le mithetho njengoba nohulumeni engamile ndawonye kodwa eqhubeka nokusebenza ukuze uma izwe libuyela kwelejoyekekile singazitholi sesibhebhethekisa igciwane njengoba lokhu kobe kuchaza ukuthi besidlala ngesikhathi inyanga yonke kungasetshenzwa.

Siyabanxusa abantu bakithi ukuba bashintshe ukwenza, bangabi womakholwa ngokubona njengeTomase waseBhayibhelini kepha

baphume amabanga angemade uma kunesidingo esithinta impilo kuphela njengoba kubeka imigomo.

Siyabanxusa ukuba babambisane nabezokugcinwa komthetho ngokukhombisa izimvume ezifanele. Siyadinga ukubonga kubo bonke abasebenzi baseNingizimu Afrika abaphoqwa wuhlobo lwemisebenzi yabo ukuba basebenze kulesi sikhathi ukuhlenga impilo yabantu esengcupheni.

Siyadinga ukubakhuthaza ngaso sonke isikhathi sibanike nezinsizakusebenza khona bangangeni engcupheni batheleleke nokungagcina kuthelela nemindeni yabo kanjalo nemiphakathi abaphila kuyona.

Abafundi ngabanye babantu abasenkingeni kakhulu kulesi sikhathi samanje nokumele bazame konke okusemandleni ukusebenzisa isikhathi sokuhlala ekhaya ukuthi bafunde ukuze ingqondo ingasaleli emuva ezifundweni. Miningi imizamo esiyenziwe wuhulumeni ukubalekelela ngakhoke abazali ababasize bakwazi ukuyisebenzisa leyo mizamo.

Sibhekene nomsebenzi onzima esigabeni sohulumeni baseMakhaya koMasipala ngoba yilapho imiphakathi iphila khona futhi uguquko lokuziphatha kwabantu kumele luqale khona ukuze kube nomehluko ekubhebhethakeni kwesifo nokuthi silwe naso size siphele.

Ngakolunye uhlangothi kumele siphakele umphakathi wakithi zonke izidingo ngqangi zempilo njengamanzi, ugesi, ukuthuthwa kwendle, ukuthuthwa kukadoti njalo.

Siyafisa ukuthi abantu bakithi babambisane nathi kulo mshikashika, bahlale behlanzekile, bageze izandla ngensipho, baqikelele ibanga phakathi kwabo, basebenzise indololwane uma beficwa wukukhwehlela kumbe ukuthimula, basebenzise konke okugunyaziwe ukuzivikela bona kanye nabantu abaseduze nabo bemukele abazobahlola izimpawu ezindlini zabo kumbe bavakashele izikhungo zezempilo ngokushesha uma benezinsolo.

City of uMhlathuze operations during & beyond COVID-19

“ This will be our new normal during and after the COVID-19 pandemic. ”

The City of uMhlathuze is fully operational during the COVID-19 national lockdown with all services provided remotely, telephonically and online. Where possible, arrangements are made prior for any necessary service that requires any physical meeting so as to ensure all precautionary measures are in place before such meeting or briefing takes place.

Following all government regulations, COVID-19 health protocols and to ensure safety of all employees, customers and service providers, the City remains open to assist with all services under the stipulated guidelines.

The City is working on the reconfiguration of some facilities, installing perspex screens at frontline desks, demarcation for social distancing rules, displaying awareness information and instructive signages to remind everyone to wear a mask and relay other messages relevant to employees and customers.

The state of readiness also includes the screening of staff members in line with the City of uMhlathuze COVID-19 Occupational Health and Safety Protocol.

Preparing of the reopening of offices also covers the temperature checks

and ensures hygiene as well as the compulsory wearing of face masks is adhered to by all before entering City of uMhlathuze facilities and offices.

All customers, members of the public and service providers are encouraged to utilise the 24-hour toll-free line to enquire and or report on any service delivery information.

More online payment methods and channels have been extended to make things easier to pay at your convenience.

The staff compliment in the City is considerate of the percentage regulated by the national government. Some employees are still working from home and that includes those that are classified under vulnerable groups such as heavily pregnant, aged over 60 years with chronic underlying diseases, etc.

It must be noted that some of the section of the City will be opened in the near future such as licensing as well as Rates Hall, which are permitted on Level 3.

The City will indicate when these are operational.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Licensing: This section operates with the national eNatis System owned and controlled by the Department of Transport. Municipalities are providing a third party to the department. Provincial Inspectors have visited all our sites to ensure safety.

Customers are encouraged to keep on visiting our social media pages and media announcements to get up to date information. Our toll free line (0800 222 827) can also be useful in this regards.

Essential Services: All essential services: waste management, fire and rescue services, disaster management, Traffic, Security and the Occupational Clinic have been operating on a normal schedule since the lockdown began. Collection at business sites continued, unless particular businesses, like hotels, were closed. All these services remain operational.



Maintenance of uMhlathuze Stadium: Preparations are currently underway for maintenance of the stadium and other key facilities. This plan aligns to the Level 3 permission for professional teams to play without spectators. Facilities used for non-professional sport and recreation remain closed until further directives.

Halls, Libraries, Thusong Centres, Beaches and Community Parks: All these facilities remain closed in Level 3. Restrictions will be eased as per directives from respective Ministers.

Cemeteries: Richards Bay and eSikhaleni cemeteries have been in operation since the lockdown. Bookings are done at offices in those cemeteries during business hours. Mourners are still restricted to 50 persons or less. Laying to rest a COVID-19 corpse is still subjected to Environmental Health protocols.

Air Quality Monitoring: This service was closed but will resume in Level 3.

Landfill Site: The regional landfill site is operated by King Cetshwayo District Municipality. The dumping site has been open since Level 5 lockdown and continues to be open. Recyclers are now permitted to function, taking into consideration all the safety precautions.

MAYORS RESPONSE

UMHLATHUZE MAYOR RESPONDS TO NTAMBANANA COMMUNITY GRIEVANCES

CITY of uMhlathuze Mayor Cllr Mduduzi Mhlongo, has swiftly responded to grievances by Ntambanana community raised through a public protest. Mhlongo, Deputy Mayor Cllr Dudu Sibiya and the Speaker Cllr Slondile Mkhize, attended to the community protest where they received a memorandum of grievances and

promised to respond to them within a week. Mhlongo honoured that promise and addressed Ntambanana community in Ward 33, and clarified all the points raised by community members.

ON HUMAN SETTLEMENT PROCESS

Mhlongo took the community to confidence that 1500 houses will be constructed in Luwamba and technical work is underway preceded by the building of top structures, which are actual houses. "The government was adamant to continue with rural housing projects citing the fact that most people especially youth are moving towards towns. We have held several engagements with the KZN Department of Human Settlement and eventually agreed to continue with this project. The next process will be to properly constitute the Project Steering Committee, train it on procedures and regulations before it begins its work. In this process, there will be no one who will do the beneficiary lists except for the PSC working with municipal officials," Mhlongo explained.

ON SUKUMA SAKHE HOUSES

Mhlongo explained that the process to identify beneficiaries of Operation Sukuma Sakhe (OSS) houses was done around 2015 and some only received foundation slabs with no top structure. "This has since been rectified by all stakeholders involved and the project is taking off. These are temporary structures to assist the most needy and vulnerable while they await the permanent structures on the Luwamba Housing Project. The beneficiaries were



identified by the Operation Sukuma Sakhe structures in the then Ntambanana Municipality," Mhlongo explained.

ON P700 ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Mhlongo told the Ntambanana community members that he did interact with the KZN Department of Transport to get the update on the P700 tar road, which links uLundi and eMpangeni. "The report we got is that there are labour challenges stalling the project but the department is working on it with two traditional authorities that are involved. We will monitor the situation and intervene where we can to speed up the process," Mhlongo said. He also mentioned that there are plans to build the damaged bridge in due course. With regards to access roads, Mhlongo explained that the gravel roads were graded in December and again in January 2020, but due to severe rains, the gravel was washed away. "We have discussed this with the Roads Team and will deploy our resources again in the ward," Mhlongo explained.

ON WATER SUPPLY

Mhlongo acknowledged the water challenges in the ward being the most rural ward and explained that since 2016 the City has installed 162 water tanks and filled by 3 water tankers on daily basis, except if weather doesn't permit. "Water reticulation projects are already underway to supply Wards 31,31 and 33. The City is has begun to build a reservoir that will source water from Mpangeni and eNseleni. On top of that, our team is investigating measures to resuscitate old water schemes that were left dysfunctional by the then Municipality. Other responses were provided on the High Mast Light that Eskom needs to power since the area is supplied directly by Eskom. The deadline of the end of March was set aside for this to happen. Members of the community were also again given a chance to ask clarity seeking questions of which responses were furnished.

Lolu hlelo luthakaswe kakhulu ngabemboni yezokuthutha njengoba inhlango iSantaco ilushayele ihlombe yabonga umasipala ngokucabangela amakhasimende abo.
