## I. INTRODUCTION

An integrated development plan is the principal strategic planning instrument, which guides and informs all planning and development, and all decisions with regard to planning, management and development, in the municipality. All municipalities are obliged by the Municipal Systems Act (2000) to adopt a process set out in writing to guide the planning, drafting, adoption and review of its Integrated Development Plan (IDP). This legislation envisages that municipalities will engage in an in-depth and meaningful way with local communities when determining the key priority areas for development. Participation of affected and interested parties ensures that the IDP addresses the real issues that are experienced by the citizens of a municipality. This in-depth programme of action has to flow directly from the needs of the people, and that development decisions are not made and imposed on communities in a top-down manner.

The municipality must through appropriate mechanisms; processes and procedures consult the local community before adopting the process. The role of councillors is very important whilst also including the environment of close collaborations with the organised formations within civil society to try and ensure that the view of civic organisations, youth, women and the religious sector are heard in the IDP process.

UMhlathuze Municipality gave notice to the local community of the particulars of the process it intends to follow. The community had to be consulted on its development needs and priorities. The local community and organs of state, including traditional authorities, and other role players were consulted during the public participation period.

In order to ensure certain minimum quality standards of the IDP, and proper coordination between and within spheres of government, the preparation of the **Process Plan** has been regulated in the Municipal Systems Act (2000).

## II. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

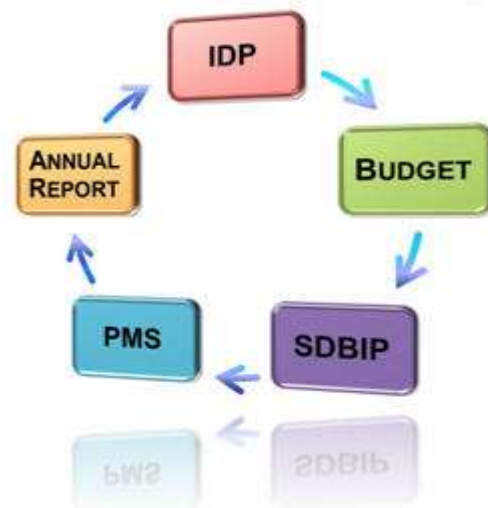
The IDP Strategy aims to ensure that the people of the City of uMhlathuze are at the centre of planning and development in the City. The IDP and Budget review processes with community and stakeholders were conducted during 31 August – 30 November 2023, schedule to be displayed below. In these sessions, residents were able to

participate and raise the issues and priorities that they consider needs to be included in the Cities plans for the 2024/2025 and beyond. The purpose of the report is to provide an overview of the procedure and approach followed to involve the broad public and all stakeholders in the Integrated Development Planning Process. It also details the adherence to the Process Plan adopted by the uMhlathuze Municipality. Most importantly it provides Ward-Based development priorities and needs obtained from the public during the clustered public participation sessions.

### III. IDP PROCESS PLAN FOR 2024/2025

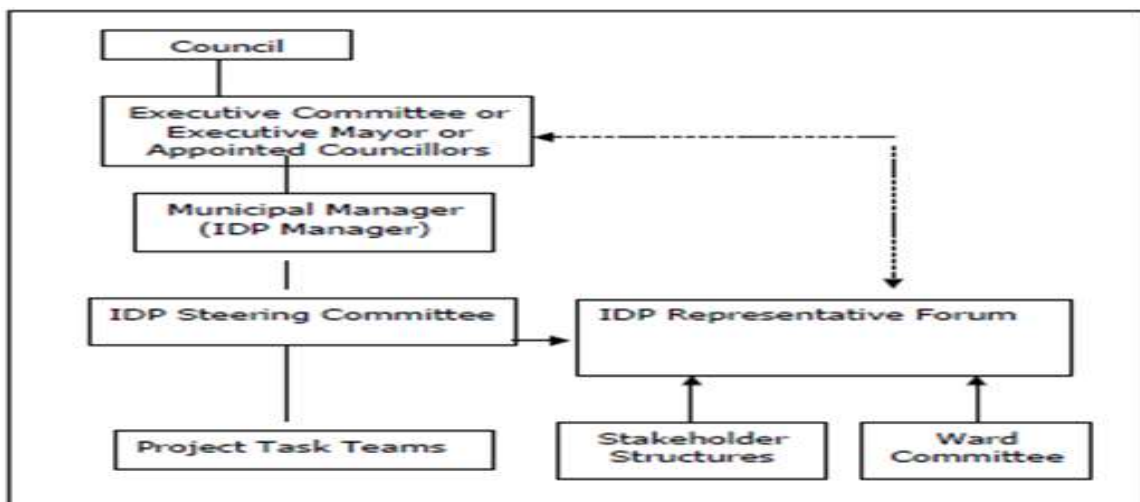
The uMhlathuze Municipality prepared a 2024/2025 Process Plan (**DMS1610524**) according to the required stipulations by the Department of Co-operative Governance & Traditional Affairs. In terms of Section 28(3) of the Municipal Systems Act, a notice was published notifying the public of the process and the availability of the Process Plan (**DMS1628394**).

Input and comments were invited on the Draft Process Plan and thereafter the Plan was considered by the different council structures, including the Public Participation Portfolio, Executive Committee and Council. The Process Plan determined the methodology and process for the formulation of the IDP Review document. As per section of MSA 2000 the Draft process plan was submitted to KZN COGTA for assessment and comments. Comments are captured in letter by COGTA under **DMS1562435**. The Final IDP Process Plan for 2024/2025 (**DMS1610524**) incorporating COGTA's comments was adopted by Council on 10 August 2023, under **Council Resolution number 16515**.



#### IV. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

It is important to define the roles and responsibilities of the various parties involved in the Integrated Development Plan (IDP) review process. This ensures that the IDP Review process is finalised within the given time frame and according to the prescribed procedure with wide participation and involvement. The major role players in this process are indicated in the organisational structure below, as adopted by council in the IDP Process plan 2024/2025.



#### V. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Section 16 of the Municipal Systems Act prescribes that a municipality must develop a culture of participatory governance, and must for this purpose encourage, and create conditions for the local community to participate in the affairs of the local municipality, including in the preparation, implementation and review of its integrated development plan. Further the municipality must establish appropriate mechanisms, which take into consideration the special needs of people who cannot read or write, people with disabilities, women and other disadvantaged groups when developing or reviewing its integrated development plan.

Engagement with communities and stakeholders is a legislated process and a vital tool to help the City make robust decisions on service delivery priorities. The City adopted a cluster approach towards the IDP consultations. In addition to the cluster

meetings, digital tools for engagement, providing effective and appealing visualisation and interactive channels for engagement were considered, for example Mayor's Interview on Radio Stations, Live Facebook Streams and 1KZN Local Television.

The time schedule for the IDP Roadshows is presented below, however dates and some venues were amended from the adopted schedule, this was done due to unforeseen circumstances including weather patterns.

### **i. Mechanisms for Public Participation**

The general public were informed of the Integrated Development plan review process and were requested to participate and have an input on the municipal development plan by voicing out their priority needs and aspirations.

#### **To note:**

- It is important to acknowledge the role played by ward councillors and ward committees to ensure that these meetings were well attended and that maximum participation was realised despite many changes that took place.
- All cluster meetings were a success and well attended.



**ii. Officials delegated during the IDP Public Participation Meetings**

Attendance by senior management and officials was commended taking into consideration that some meetings were also held during weekdays. Consistent support given by all departments in making sure that these meetings were conducted successfully was greatly appreciated. The level of professionalism and knowledge offered by the officials who were presenting on different subjects is commendable.

**iii. Meetings Procedure**

The background to the Integrated Development Plan review process within the context of local government transition was explained by the His Worship the Mayor, Cllr. X Ngwezi. An overview of the 2023/2024 budgeted capital projects per department and key issues were discussed as well as the confirmation of needs from the public.



It must be noted that all these meetings were facilitated with great success and honour by the Speaker, Cllr. T.S Gumede who enabled the audience to participate effectively; all wards were given equal opportunity to express their concerns and priority issues.

Responses were given by the Mayor, Speaker and City Manager. Some issues raised in these meetings needed quick interventions by the municipality, of which some were attended to, physical visits and inspections were done in some of the reported cases were also done.

The language of the majority was used to communicate and facilitate the meeting, however where possible various languages were used to accommodate all racial language needs. There is still a need for a municipality to employ the use of a sign language interpreter to accommodate all communities including the deaf society.

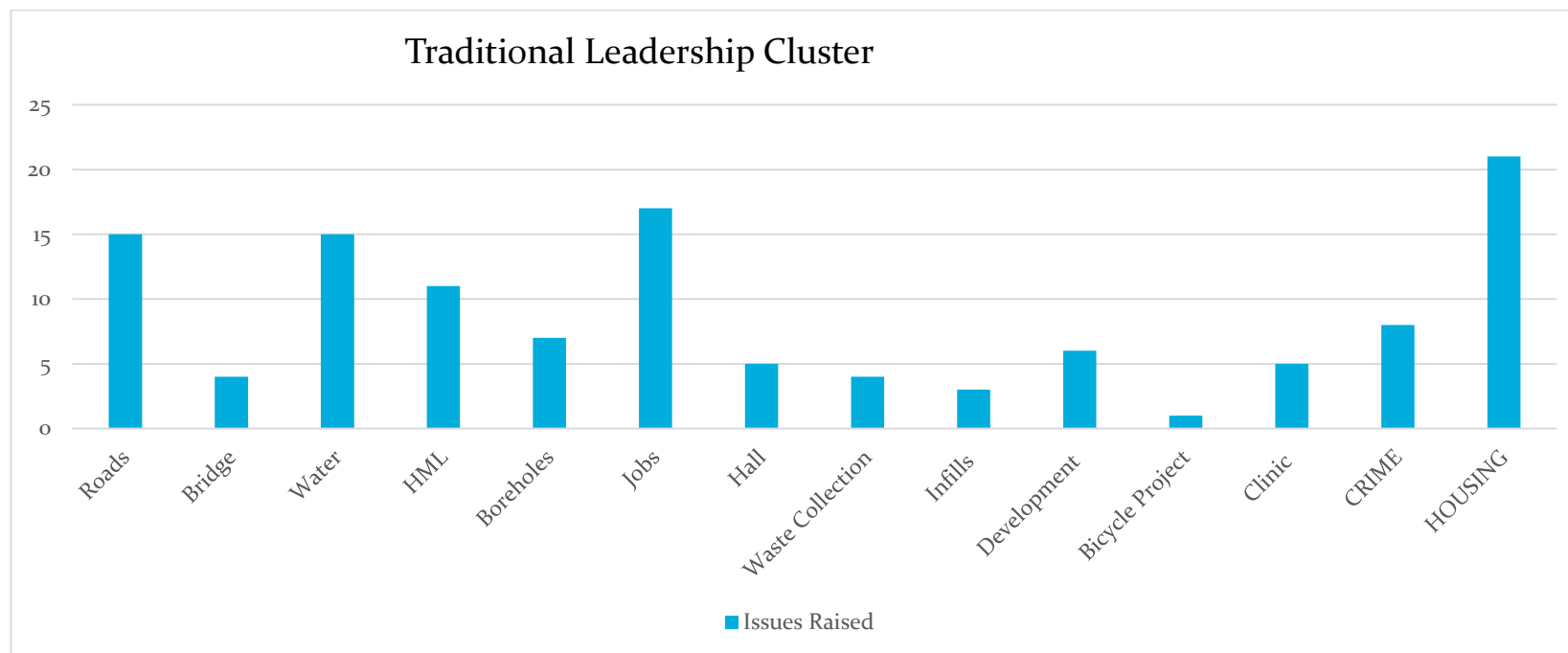

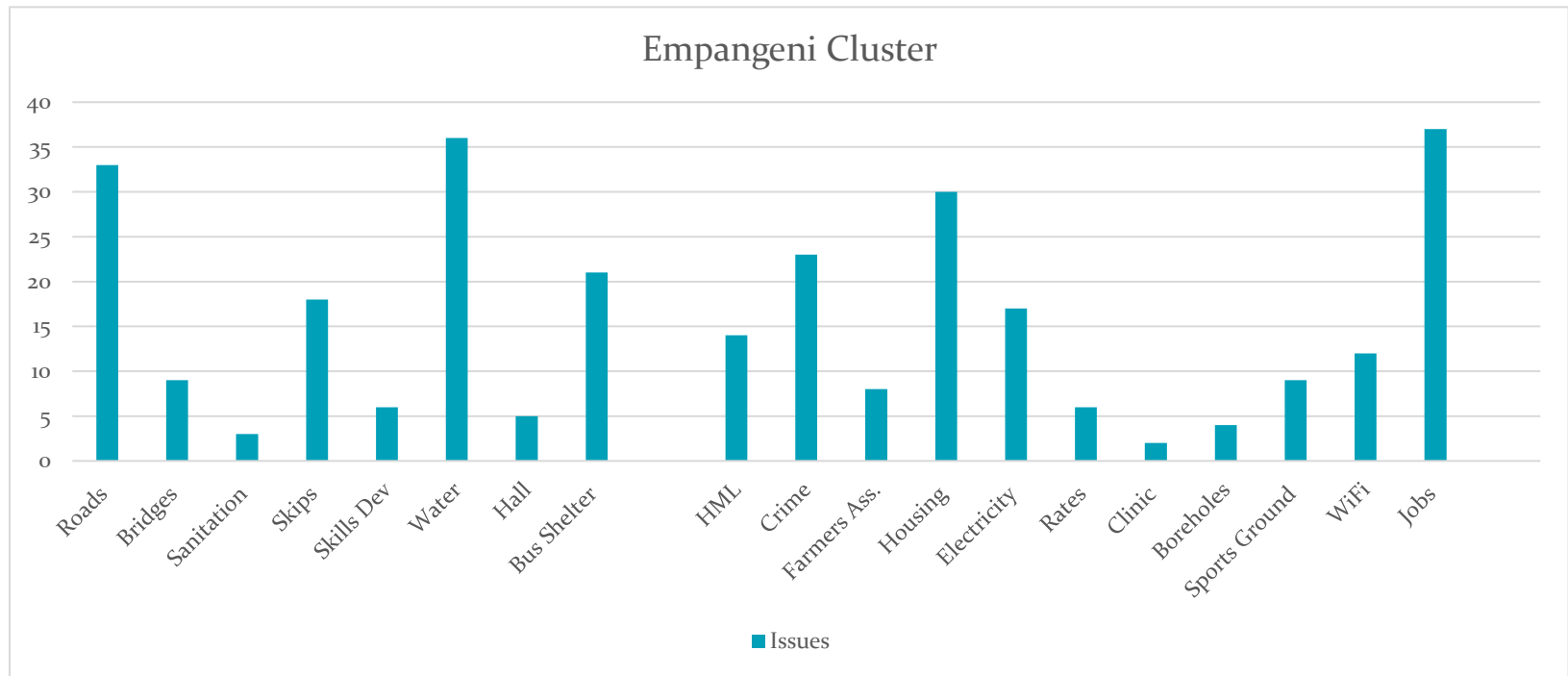


Figure 4: EMpangeni Cluster – Priority Issues

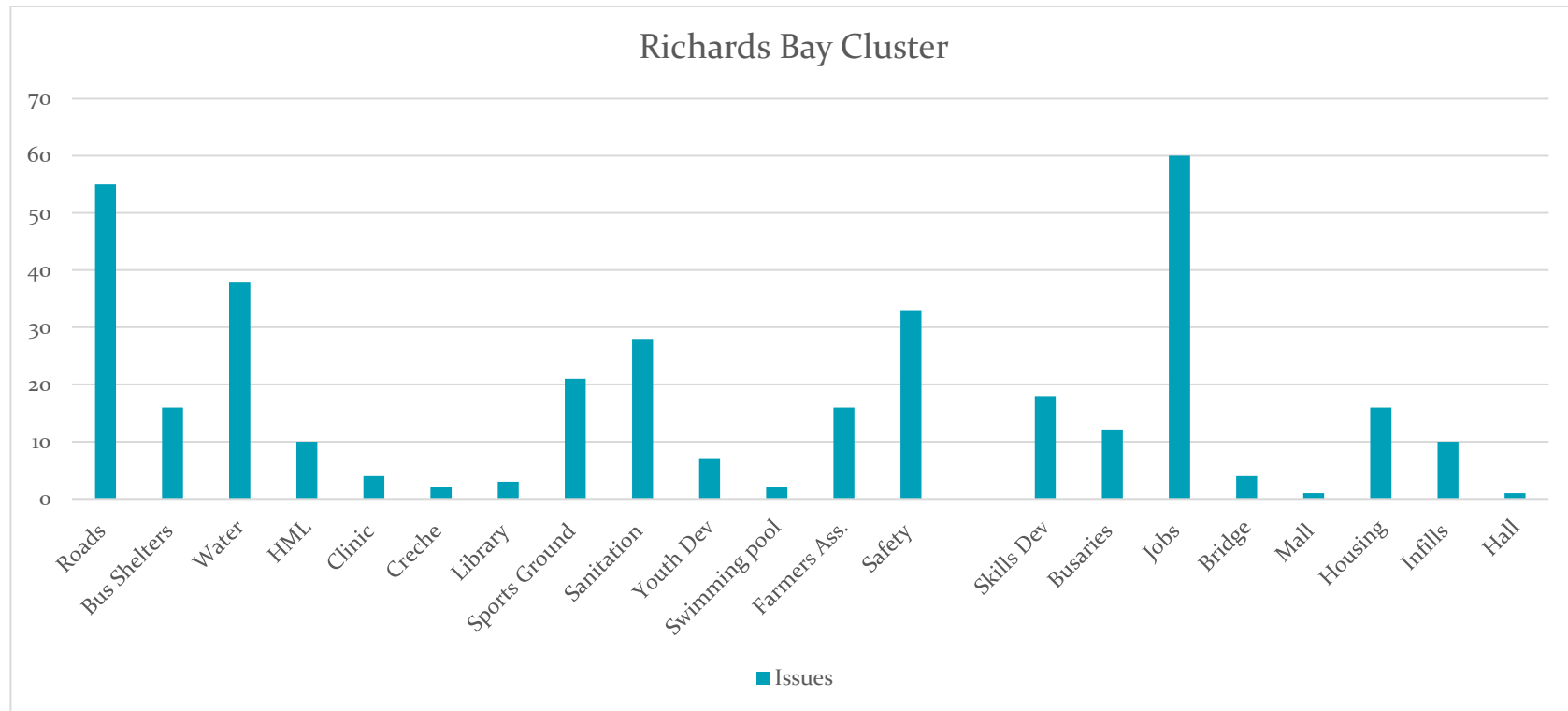

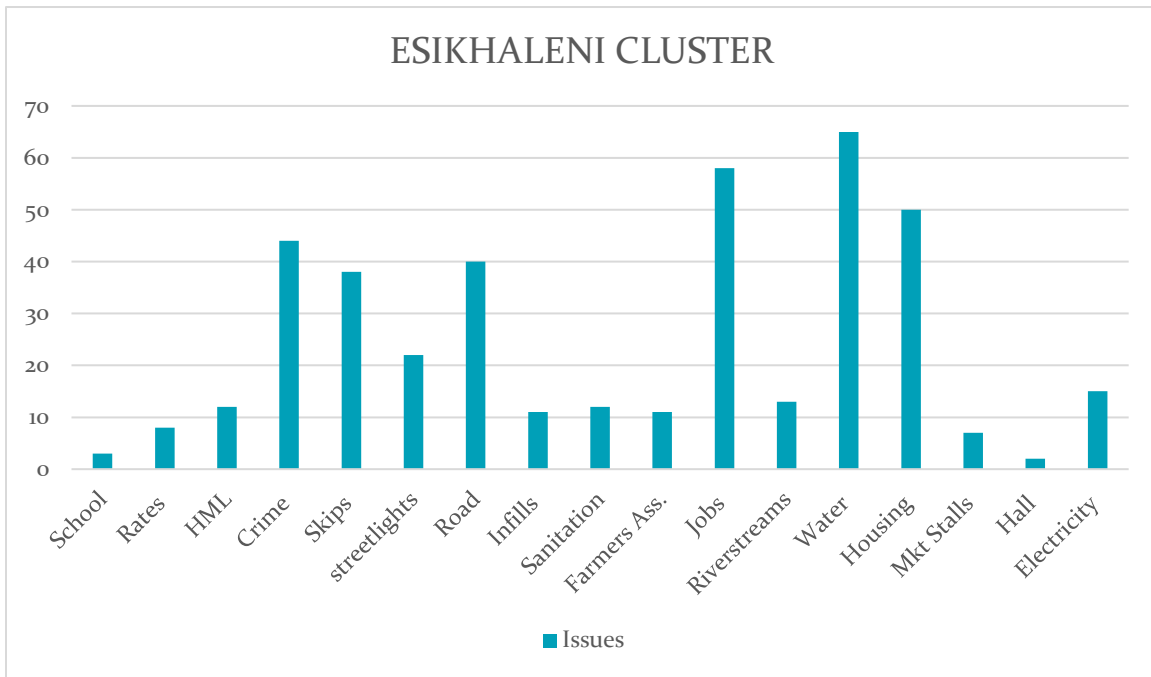

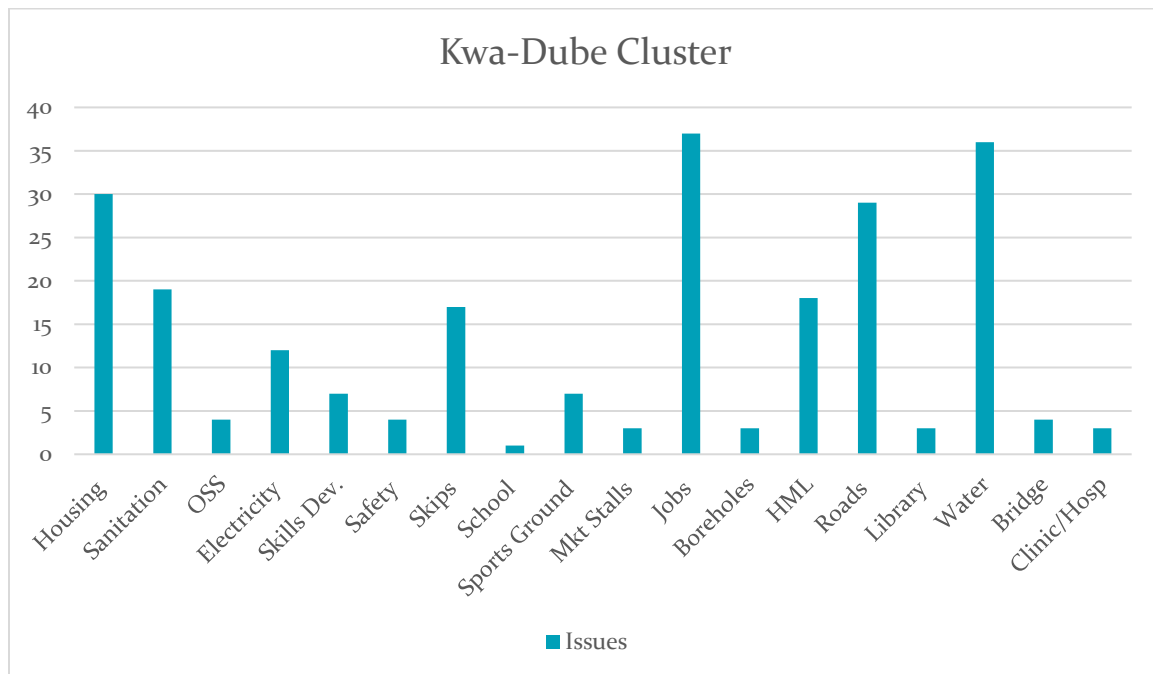
