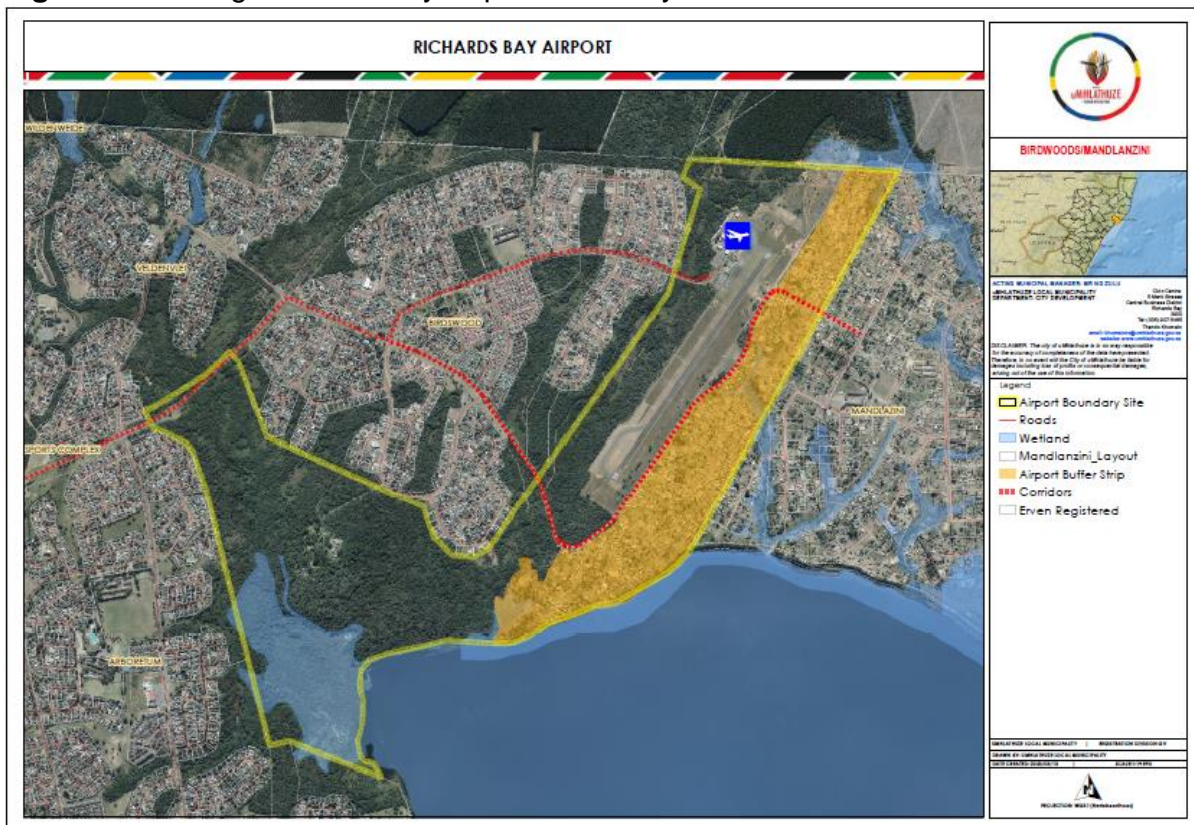

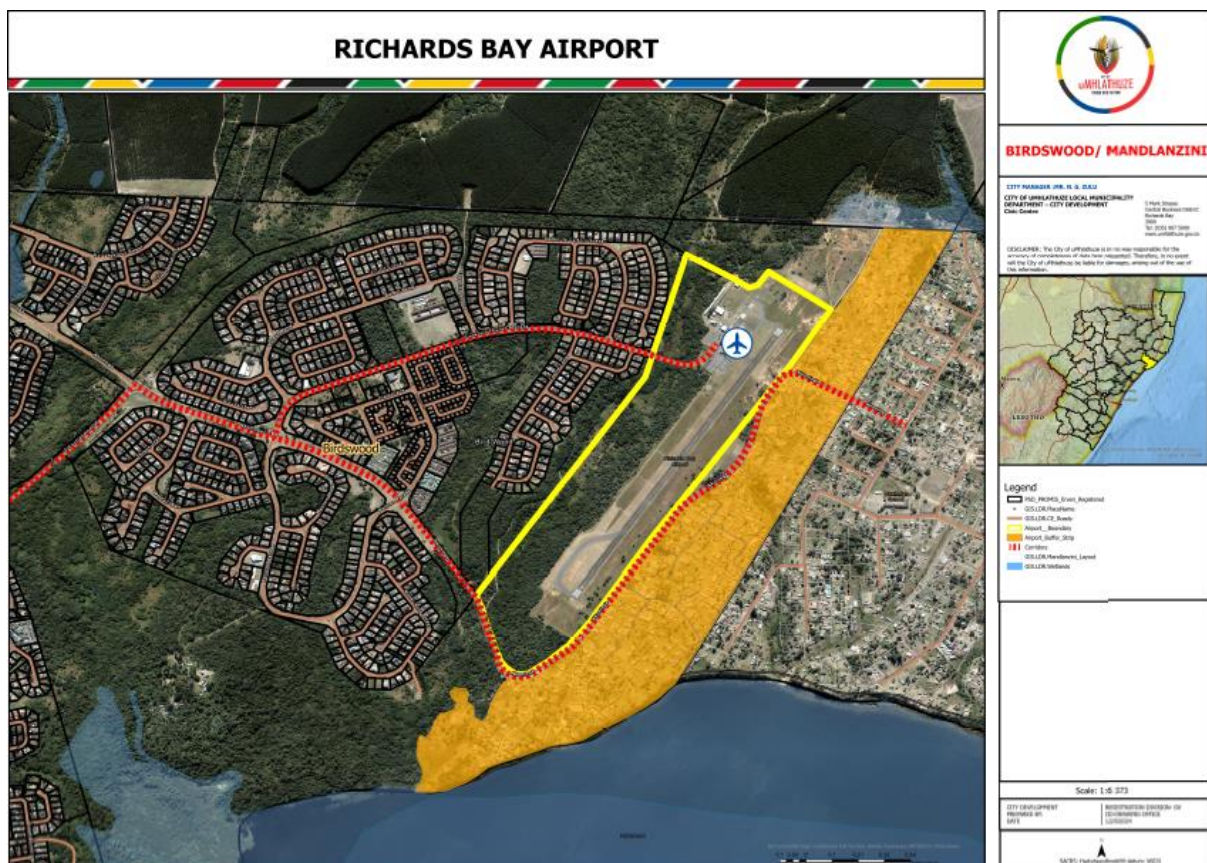


- **Phase 2:** the submission of the draft diagram/s for approval to the SG's Office. This phase will take place once the SPLUMA application has been finalized by the Municipality.
